GOD-TRACKING IS BEING DELIGHTED IN THE HAPPINESS FOUND IN FOLLOWING CHRIST

Delight yourself in the LORD, and he will give you the desires of your heart.

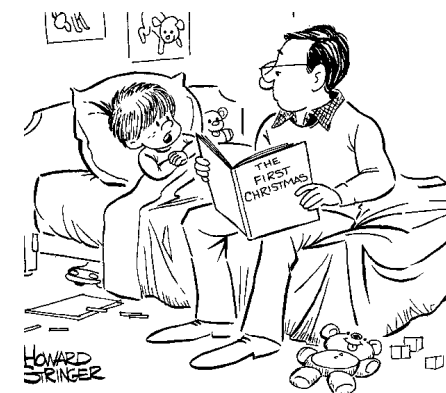
