ITS GETTING COLD - BEWARE!

Do you have gas furnaces and/or appliances at home? Do you have a carbon monoxide detector at home? Natural gas is a safe and reliable energy source. However, gas burners can produce deadly carbon monoxide when not adjusted properly.

Remember these tips:

- ~ Appliances should be vented properly. Without it, gas will produce carbon monoxide.
- ~ Keep chimneys and flues clear of all de-
- ~ Never use generators in enclosed places or in garages.
- ~ Natural gas should ALWAYS burn BLUE.
- ~ Flames should be steady, not move or float or roll.
- ~ Appliances should not have soot above the burner.

Symptoms of Carbon Monoxide Poisoning

Headache Dizziness Fatigue Nausea Inability to think clearly

If you think you have carbon monoxide poisoning, go to the nearest emergency room.
