FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

This Sunday is Halloween, but it is also Reformation Sunday and the father of the Protestant Reformation, Martin Luther, will play a prominent part in my sermon. Dietrich Bonhoeffer, in his book *The Cost of Discipleship* writes, "It was not justification of sin, but the justification of the sinner that drove Luther from the cloister back into the world. The grace he had received was costly grace. It was grace, for it was like water on parched ground, comfort in tribulation, freedom from the bondage of a self-chosen way of forgiveness of all his sins. And it was costly, for, so far from dispensing him from good works; it meant that he must take the call to discipleship more seriously than ever before. It was grace because it cost so much, and it cost so much because it was grace."
